### 2004 ADARA

Named after a star in the Canis Major constellation, our 2004 Adara is a blend of Carignane, Grenache, Mourvedre and Syrah, four grape varieties common to the Rhone Valley of France. It has soft tannins and lively fresh fruit flavors of strawberries, plums and wild blueberries with hints of sage and lavender. Adara is great alone or with a wide variety of foods including pasta, pork, chicken and lamb.
